

INVITATION

The Youth Nordic Council (UNR) will hold its annual session from Friday the 23^{rd} of October until Sunday the 25^{th} in Reykjavik, Iceland. The theme of this year's session is "**Nordics in the school**", the session starts on Friday the 23^{rd} of October with a seminar that touches on the theme.

Traditionally, the UNR session is held in conjunction with the **Nordic Council session**. Participants in the UNR session can also participate in the Nordic Council session, which will be held **26-29.10**. in **Reykjavik**. Please note that you must register separately for the Nordic Council session!

One representative from each UNR member organization and organizations with observer status are invited to participate in the UNR session and in the Nordic Council session. The participation fee is $250 \in$ for registration between 24.8.-6.9.2020. The participation fee will be $320 \in$ if registration is made between 7.-13.9.2020. The participation fee also includes trips from the capital of each country and autonomous area, accommodation in two-person rooms as well as meals during the seminar and UNR session. Please note that only travel between countries is reimbursed, travel within a country is not reimbursed. The participation fee also includes overnight stays during the Nordic Council session if one participates in it.

If your organization wants to send more than one participant to the session, the organization will be responsible for costs related to accommodation and meals for the additional participant. The extra participants should organize their own travel arrangements, while UNR can organize accommodation and meals for extra participants. UNR will send an invoice for the extra participants accommodation and meals.

The registration-form is found online at UNR's website <u>www.unginorden.org</u> and sent by e-mail after the registration has been opened on the 24th of August. All participants should register before 13.9.2020. The deadline for the submission of motions for resolutions, etc. can be found in the attached documents.

Participating in the UNR session provides an excellent opportunity to discuss interesting topics, to share experiences and to establish contacts with other young Nordic people. For decades, many of today's decision makers have been active in UNR and made important contacts that they have benefited greatly from.
