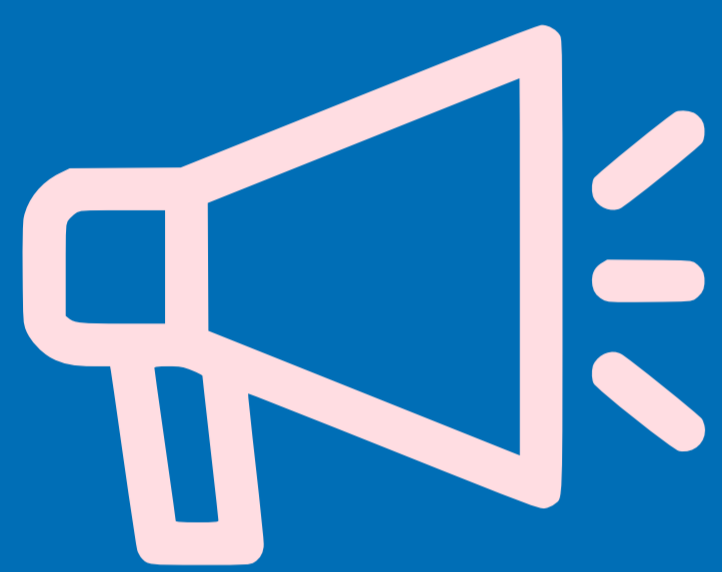
Point of order

Show your participant card and make an "O" with your arms.

Do I have to announce when I leave the room?

During agenda points where we vote, we need to know how many of the delegates are present to ensure the voting record. This means that delegates (not extra delegates, observers or guests) should give their delegate number to the secretariat in case they have to leave the room during voting.



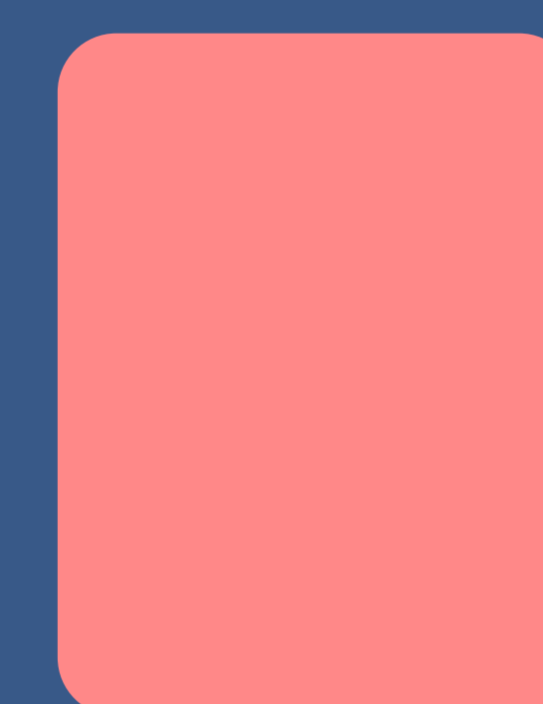
How and when to submit an amendment:

Amendments can be made until the time specified by the chair of the meeting.

Submit via the QR code or the link on the session website.

How do we vote on a resolution?

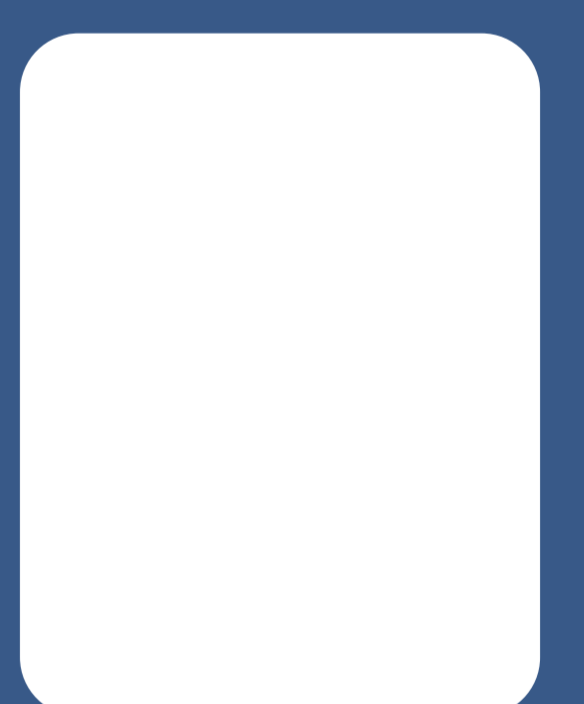
1. Chair of the working group presents the resolution
2. Delegates have the opportunity to ask to reject the resolution, in which case a vote is taken immediately (without debate). The resolution can be rejected by a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority.
3. Debate on the resolution in its entirety and the opportunity to submit amendments
4. The opportunity to submit amendments is closed
5. Voting of proposed amendments will take place in a chronological order. If there are several amendments at the same place in the resolution, the most contrasting amendment will be dealt with first, and if it is adopted, other amendments in the same will be seen as invalid.
6. Vote on the resolution in its new entirety

The chair of the meeting is authorized to cut speaking time if necessary, for example when many people have signed up for the debate, and to close the list of speakers.

If unclear, always ask and the meeting chair will clarify.

Glossary

Participants

Everyone present during the session

Delegate

Has voting rights

Delegation

Those representing a member organization of a specific umbrella organization

Observer

Can speak and propose but cannot vote

Guest

Do not have speaking or voting rights

Point of order

A practical question about the procedure. Goes first in the list of speakers

Reply

A direct response to something that has just been said at the podium. You can only ask for a reply if you have been directly mentioned at the podium. For example, name, umbrella organization or country.

Statutes

The rules that determine what the Nordic Youth Council can do. The statutes can be changed by the Session with a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority.

Rules of procedure

Adopted at each session and regulates how the session is conducted.

Point of information

Adds only facts to the debate topic
